Construction of a new 7,000 square foot bank branch for United Community Bank in Springfield, Illinois.

Project included:

- new site work.
- construction of a new wood frame structure with brick veneer and standing seam metal roof.
- construction of an attached 6-lane drive up canopy.
- new concrete parking lot.

Project Details

- Placement of 5,000 cubic yards of fill to raise the existing site 2 feet.
- Construction of over 25,000 square feet of concrete pavement for parking and drive-up.
- Steel erection for an attached 6-lane drive up canopy.
- New underground storm water discharge and storage system.
- Custom millwork and cabinetry for new teller lines.

Unique Challenges

- Coordination with multiple prime mechanical and electrical contractors
- Coordination with bank equipment supplied by owner
- Work adjacent to high traffic areas
- Site development using GPS technology for grading and layout
- Temporary heating required for start date in winter months.
